



- USDA touches the life of every American almost daily
- 100,000+ employees

- UAIP- Competitive Grants support urban agriculture and innovative production activities
- Since launch in 2020 has invested \$47.5 million in 184 grants.
- We have grants in 41 states and territories, but eligibility is limited to certain entity types





Composting and Food Waste Reduction Agreements

- CFWR provides funding to develop and test strategies for food waste reduction and composting
- Since launch in 2020 has invested \$12.1 million in 82 agreements
- Agreements are in 32 states and territories, but eligibility is limited to certain entity types

Duties:


- develop recommendations on policies, initiatives, and outreach


