<u>Agriculture and Innovative Production</u> - NUag welcomed the next wave of 10 Urban Ag cities to join the NUag Initiative.

USDA Makes Acreage Reporting Improvements to Allow Flexibility for Urban and Innovative Producers | Farm Service Agency - This change will allow more urban and innovative farmers better access USDA programs. USDA now allows for reporting down to 0.0001 acres or a space about 2.5" by 2.5".

<u>USDA Invests Approximately \$11.5 Million in Composting and Food Waste</u>

<u>Reduction Projects in 23 States | USDA</u> - The \$11 million dollar plan will contribute to food security and includes plans to redistribute compost to urban and local growers.

The time is ripe to support urban agriculture: Experts urge Congress to fund new iteration of Farm Bill - Advocates publish a policy bill to put pressure on Congress to fully fund the Department of Agriculture's Office of Urban Agriculture and Innovative Production which has been in limbo since September 2023.

Raising chickens, ducks, and bees allowed in Detroit under new urban farming rules- Detroit passes a bill that allows for bees, ducks and chickens to be kept on urban farms. The community members that advocate on behalf of Detroit's 2,300 urban farms have been pushing for a livestock ordinance since 2013.

How a U.S. Army veteran went from battlefields to mushroom farming- Farmer spotlight - Urban Farmer Steve who was a former Veteran and turned to mushroom farming and the rise and importance of black and brown veteran farmer programs.
